aental Tax 101

Understanding Delaware's New Statewide Rental Tax

The Basics

HS 2/HB 168 was signed into law in September, and will go into effect January 1, 2025. This bill enacts a 4.5% state tax on all short-term rental properties, and requires that accommodations intermediaries acquire a \$25 state license. If you rent out your property on a short-term basis, this legislation applies to you. <u>Click here</u> to review the bill in its entirety.

State Licensing

"Accommodations intermediary" means any person or company engaged in the business of facilitating a short-term rental to an occupant on a website or other means. If you own a short-term rental property, but you exclusively use a third party (property manager/real estate agent) to handle the renting of your property, you are **not** considered an accommodations intermediary. However, if you facilitate these bookings, such as AirBNB or VRBO hosting, or direct bookings, you **are** an accommodations intermediary, and must acquire a <u>state license</u>.

Rental Tax

The state short-term rental tax is 4.5% of the rent upon every occupancy of a short-term rental within the state. This does not include cleaning fees, insurance, linen rental fees, other add-on fees, or municipal taxes. Accommodations intermediaries are generally responsible for collecting and remitting this tax. The amount of the tax collected for each month shall be reported and paid over to the <u>State Division of Revenue</u> no later than the fifteenth day of the month following the month of collection.

But... I Already Pay Rental Tax to Dewey Beach!

The state rental tax is separate from the 3% accommodations tax here in Dewey Beach (enacted in 2009 by Ordinance 661). Property owners of short-term rentals within the town of Dewey Beach will still be responsible for the 3% accommodations tax, as well as their annual town rental license.

Dewey Beach is not responsible for any billing or oversight of the state rental tax, but we are here to help our property owners navigate this change.

How Will the Tax Revenue Be Utilized by the State?

- 62.5% to the state general fund
- 12.5% to the beach preservation fund
- 12.5% to the convention and visitors bureau in each county
- 12.5% to the Delaware Tourism Office



SAFETY & REGULATIONS

The goal of town staff is to welcome all of our visitors, protect the public, and ensure safe travel back to their destination at the end of the evening. Safety is a shared responsibility.

- Start 2025 off right! Have a travel plan, and stick to it. At the time of publishing, rideshare promo codes
 have not yet been released. We recommend keeping an eye on <u>Lyft</u> and <u>Uber</u>, as NYE promo codes are
 sometimes offered. Don't forget you can schedule ahead with rideshare companies. Reserve your ride
 today.
- Local hotels and residential rentals have great rates in the off-season. Don't drive... stay with us! There's nothing better than waking up at the beach.
- Dewey Beach maintains a <u>curfew</u> for minors year round. Persons under the age of 18 must be off the
 street by 11:00pm each evening. While we pride ourselves on being a family-friendly destination, in the late
 evening hours, most businesses cater to crowds 21 and over. For the safety of our younger visitors, parents
 should ensure their children are at their home or rental by 11:00pm.
- The Dewey Beach Police will be out and about throughout New Years Eve and New Years Day. We're here
 to keep you safe! If you see suspicious behavior or require assistance, please call 911 or alert an officer
 directly.
- As always, while you're here, you're a member of the Dewey Beach family. Look out for one another. If you notice a person that may require assistance, confront them, and ask if they need help. Recruit support from business employees or police when necessary.


